## Recommended Rotary Club By-Laws

## Bylaws of the Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar Heritage

Note:- These bylaws are recommended only and may be changed by any Rotary club to meet its own conditions, provided such changes are not out of harmony with the standard Rotary Club Constitution and with the RI constitution, RI bylaws and the Rotary Code of policies. If any doubt exists, the proposed charges should be submitted to the general secretary for the consideration of the Board of Directors of RI.

#### Article 1 Definitions.

Board : The Board of Directors of this club.

Director : A member of this club's Board of Directors.

Member : A member, other than an honorary member, of this club.

4. RI : Rotary International.

Year : The twelve - month period that begins on 1 July.

#### Article 2 Board.

The Governing body of the club shall be the board consisting of 11 (Eleven) members of this club, namely, the president, vice president, president elect ( or president –nominee, if no successor has been elected), secretary, treasurer and the sergeant at aims. At the discretion of the board also added can be \_\_\_\_\_ directors elected in accordance with article 3, section 1 of these bylaws, and the immediate past president.

#### Article 3 Election of Directors and Officers

Section 1 – At a regular meeting one month prior to the meeting for election of officers, the presiding officer shall ask for nominations by members of the club for president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and 5 (five) directors. The nominations may be presented by a nominating committee or by members from the floor, by either or by both as a club may determine. If it is determined to use a

nominating committee, such committee shall be appointed as the club may determine. The nominations duty made shall be placed on a ballot in alphabetical order under each office and shall be voted for at the annual meeting. The candidates for president, vice president, secretary and treasurer receiving a majority of the votes shall be declared elected to their respective officers. The \_\_\_\_ candidate for director receiving a majority of the votes shall be declared elected as directors. The candidate for president elected in such balloting shall be the president nominee and serve as a director for the year commencing on the first day of July next following the election and shall assume office as president on 1 July immediately following that year. The president nominee shall take the title of president – elect on 1 July in the year prior to taking office as president.

**Section 2 – The officers** and directors, so elected, together with the immediate past president shall constitute the board. Within one week after their election, the directors elect shall meet the elect some member of the club to act as sergeant at arms.

Section 3 – A vacancy in the board or any office shall be filled by action of the remaining directors.

Section 4 – A vacancy in the position of any officer elect or director elect shall be filled by action of the remaining directors elect.

#### Article 4 Duties of Officers.

Section 1 - President. It shall be the duty of the president to preside at meetings of the club and the board and to perform other duties as ordinarily pertain to the office of president.

Section 2 — President elect. It shall be the duty of the president elect to serve as a director and to perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the president or the board.

**Section 3 –** Vice President.-It shall be the duty of the vice president to preside at meetings of the club and the board in the absence of the president and to perform other duties as ordinarily pertain to the office of vice president.

Section 4 – Secretary:-It shall be the duty of the secretary to keep membership records, record attendance at meetings send out notices of club, board and committee meetings record and preserve the minutes of such meetings report as required to RI, including the semiannual reports of membership on 1 January and 1 July of each year, which shall include per capita dues for all members and prorated dues for active members who have been elected to membership in the club since the start of the July or January semiannual reporting period, report changes in membership, provide the monthly attendance report which shall be made to the district governor within 15 days of the last meeting of the month, collect and remit RI of official magazine subscriptions and the perform other duties as usually certain to the office of secretary.

**Section 5** – Treasurer: It shall be the duty of the treasurer to have custody of all funds according for it to the club annual and at any other time upon demand by the board, and to perform other duties as pertains to the office of treasurer. Upon retirement from office, the treasure shall turn over to the incoming treasurer to the president all funds , books of accounts or any other club property.

**Section 6** – Sergeant at Arms. The duties of the sergeant at aims shall be such as are usually prescribed for such office and other duties as may be prescribed by the president or the board.

#### Article 5 Meetings

**Section 1** – Annual Meeting: An annual meeting of this club shall be held on the December in each year, at which time the election of officers and directors to serve for the ensuing year shall take place.

Section 2 – The regular weekly meetings of this club shall be held on Friday at Hotel The Empires, Saheed Nagar, Bhubaneswar at 7.30 PM. Due notice of any changes in or canceling of the regular meeting shall be given to all members of the club. All members excepting an honorary member (or member excused pursuant to the standard Rotary club constitution) in good standing in this club, on the day of the regular meeting, must be counted as present or absent, and attendance must be evidenced by the members being present for at least sixty (60) percent of the

time devoted to the regular meeting, either at this club or at any other Rotary club, or as otherwise provided in the standard Rotary Club constitution, article 9 sections 1 and 2.

Section 3 – One third of the membership shall constitute a quorum at the annual and regular meetings of this club.

**Section 4** – Regular meetings of the board shall be held on 3<sup>rd</sup> Week of each month. Special meetings of the board shall be called by the president, whenever deemed necessary, or upon the request of two (2) directors, due notice having been given.

(Note:-Article 6, section 2 of the standard Rotary Club Constitution provides that "An annual meeting for the election of officers shall be held not later than 31 December ...")

Section 5 - A majority of the directors shall constitute a quorum of the board.

#### Article 6 Fees and Dues

Section 1 – The admission fee shall be INR 2,000 to be paid before the applicant can qualify as a member, except as provided for in the standard Rotary club constitution, article 11.

Section 2 – The membership dues shall be INR 10,000 per annum payable semiannually on the first day of July and January with the understanding that a portion of each semiannual payment shall be applied to each member's subscription to the RI official magazine.

#### Article 7 Method of Voting

The business of this club shall be transacted by viva voce "Vote except the election of officers and directors, which shall be by ballot. The board may determine that a specific resolution be considered by ballot rather than by viva voce vote.

#### Article 8 Four Avenues of Service

The four Avenues of Service are the philosophical and practical frame work for the work of this Rotary club. They are club service, vocational service, community service and international service. This club will be active in each of the four Avenues of service.

#### Article 9 Committees

Club committees are charged with carrying out the annual and long range goals of the club based on the four Avenues of Service. The President and immediate past president should work together to ensure continuity of leadership and succession planning. When feasible committee members should be appointed to the same committee for three years to ensure consistency. The president -elect is responsible for appointing committee members to fill vacancies, appointing committee chairs and conducting planning meetings prior to the start of the year in office. It is recommended that the chair have previous experience as a member of the committee. Standing committees should be appointed as follows.

**Members :-** The committee should develop and implement a comprehensive plan for the recruitment and retention of members.

Club Public Relations: This committee should develop and implement plans to provide the public with information about Rotary and to promote the clubs service projects and activities.

Club Administration: This committee should conduct activities associated with the effective operation of the club.

**Service Projects**:- This committee should develop and implement educational, humanitarian and vocational projects that address the needs of its community and communities in other countires.

**The Rotary Foundation :-** This committee should develop and implement plans to support The Rotary Foundation through both financial contributions and program participation.

Additional ad hoc committees may be appointed as needed.

- (a) The president shall be ex officio a member of all committees and, as such, shall have all the privileges of membership thereon.
- (b) Each committee shall transact its business as is delegated to it in these bylaws and such additional business as may be referred to it by the president or the board. Except where special authority is given by the board, such committees shall not take action until a report has been made and
- (c) Each chair shall be responsible for regular meetings and activities of the committee, shall supervise and coordinate the work of the committee, and shall report to the board on all committee activities.

(Note: The above committee structure is in hormony with both the District Leadership Plan and the Club Leadership Plan. Clubs have the discretion to create any committees that are required to effectively meet its service and fellowship needs. A sample listing of such optional committees is found in the Club Committee Manual. A club may develop a different committee structure as needed.)

#### Article 10 Duties of Committees

The duties of all committees shall be established and reviewed by the president for his or her year. In declaring the duties of each, the president shall reference to appropriate RI materials. The service projects committee will consider the Avenues of Vocational Service, Community Service, and International Service when developing plans for the year.

Each committee shall have a specific mandate, clearly defined goals, and action plans established by the beginning of each year for implementation during the course of the year. It shall be the primary responsibility of the president-elect to provide the necessary leadership to prepare a recommendation for club committees, mandates, goals, and plans for presentation to the board in advance of the commencement of the year as noted above.

#### Article 11 Leave of Absence

Upon written application to the board, setting forth good and sufficient cause, leave of absence may be granted excusing a member from attending the meetings of the club for a specified length of time.

(Note: Such leave of absence does operate to prevent a forfeiture of membership; it does not operate to give the club credit for the member's attendance. Unless the member attends a regular meeting of some other club, the excused member must be recorded as absent except that absence authorized under the provisions of the Standard Rotary Club Constitution is not computed in the attendance record of the club.)

#### Article 12 Finances

Section 1 - Prior to the beginning of each fiscal year, the board shall prepare a budget of estimated income and expenditures for the year, which shall stand as the limit of expenditures for these purposes, unless otherwise ordered by action of the board. The budget shall be broken into two separate parts: one in respect of club operations and one in respect of charitable/service operations.

Section 2 - The treasurer shall deposit all club funds in a bank, named by the board. The club funds shall be divided into two separate parts: club operations and service projects.

Section 3 - All bills shall be paid by the treasurer or other authorized officer only when approved by two other officers or directors.

Section 4 - A thorough review of all financial transactions by a qualified person shall be made once each year.

Section 5 - Officers having charge or control of club funds shall give bond as required by the board for the safe custody of the funds of the club, cost of bond to be borne by the club.

Section 6 - The fiscal year of this club shall extend from 1 July to 30 June, and for the collection of members' dues shall be divided into two (2) semiannual periods extending from 1 July to 31 December, and from 1 January to 30 June. The payment of per capita dues and RI official magazine subscriptions shall be made on 1 July and 1 January of each year on the basis of the membership of the club on those dates.

#### Article 13 Method of Electing Members

Section 1 - The name of a prospective member, proposed by an active member of the club, shall be submitted to the board in writing, through the club secretary. A transferring or former member of another club may be proposed to active membership by the former club. The proposal shall be kept confidential except as otherwise provided in this procedure.

Section 2 - The board shall ensure that the proposal meets all the classification and membership requirements of the standard Rotary club constitution.

Section 3 - The board shall approve or disapprove the proposal within 30 days of its submission and shall notify the proposer, through the club secretary, of its decision.

Section 4 - If the decision of the board is favorable, the prospective member shall be informed of the purposes of Rotary and of the privileges and responsibilities of membership, following which the prospective member shall be requested to sign the membership proposal form and to permit his or her name and proposed classification to be published to the club.

Section 5 - If no written objection to the proposal, stating reasons, is received by the board from any member (other than honorary) of the club within seven (7) days following publication of information about the prospective member, that person, upon payment of the admission fee (if not honorary membership), as prescribed in these bylaws, shall be considered to be elected to membership.

If any such objection has been filed with the board, it shall vote on this matter at its next meeting. If approved despite the objection, the proposed member, upon payment of the admission fee (if not honorary membership), shall be considered to be elected to membership.

Section 6 - Following the election, the president shall arrange for the new member's induction, membership card, and new member Rotary literature. In addition, the president or secretary will report the new member information to RI and the president will assign a member to assist with the new member's assimilation to the club as well as assign the new member to a club project or function.

Section 7 - The club may elect, in accordance with the standard Rotary club constitution, honorary members proposed by the board.

#### Article 14 Resolutions

The club shall not consider any resolution or motion to commit the club on any matter until the board has considered it. Such resolutions or motions, if offered at a club meeting, shall be referred to the board without discussion



#### Article 15 Order of Business

- Meeting called to order.
- Introduction of visitors.
- Correspondence, announcements, and Rotary information.
- Committee reports if any.
- Any unfinished business.
- Any new business.
- Address or other program features.
- Adjournment.

#### **Article 16 Amendments**

These bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting, a quorum being present, by a two-thirds vote of all members present, provided that notice of such proposed amendment shall have been mailed to each member at least ten (10) days before such meeting. No amendment or addition to these bylaws can be made which is not in harmony with the standard Rotary club constitution and with the constitution and bylaws of RI.

#### Rules and Regulations of Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar Heritage (RCBH) Social Service Society

- 01. Short Title: These Rules and Regulations shall be called the Rules and Regulations of RCBH Social Service Society.
- 02. Location of the Registered Office of the Society: At: Plot No.30/A,Unit-3, Bhubaneswar-751001
- C3. Area of Operation / Jurisdiction: State of Orissa.
- 64. Symbol: Symbol of Rotary International will be adopted by the RCBH Social Service Society. In course of time a second Symbol will be developed.
- 05. Nature of Society: RCBH Social Service Society is the Community Service Wing of the Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar Heritage functioning under the Rotary District 3262.
- 06. Members :
  - (A) Eligibility:
    - i) All members of Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar Heritage shall be Members of the RCBH Social Service Society.
    - ii) He /She pay the prescribed annual fees as decided by the General Body of the Society from time to time
  - (B) Term of Office of the Members:

A person will continue to be member of the RCBH Social Service Society, till he / she continues as Member of Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar Hentage.

- (C) Powers and Functions of the Members:
  - Participate in the Election of the Members of the Governing Body.
  - ii) Participate in the Governing Body meetings and various activities of the Society.
- 07. General Body:
- (A) Composition of the General Body.
  - The Society shall have a General Body composed of all Members of the Society. Quorum for the General Body: One third of its Members.
- (B) Powers and Functions of the General Body :

The General Body shall :-

- i) Formula policies to implement the objectives of the Society.
- ii) Elect the Members of the Governing Body.
- iii) Pass the Annual Report, Annual Budget and Audit Report(s) of the Society.
- 08. Governing Body:
- (A) Composition of the Governing Body:-

There shall be a Governing Body composed of the following office bearers and members:

- i) President, ii) Vice-President, iii) Secretary, iv) Additional Secretary, v) Treasurer vi) Members -4.
- B) The Election and Term of Office of the Governing Body.:
  - i) The office bearers and members of Governing Body shall be nominated / elected from among the members of General Body on democratic principle.
  - ii) The term of Office of the Governing Body shall be one year. If election can not be held in time due to unavoidable circumstances, the Governing Body may remain in Office for a maximum period of three months after expiry of its term.
- (C)Meeting of the Governinfg Body:
  - i) The Governing Body shall meet not less than four times in a year.
  - ii) The Secretary shall convene meeting of the Governing Body as and when required for which minimum of 3 clear days notice shall be given.
  - iii)Quorum for the Governing Body shall be One-Third of its members (with the present strength of the Governing Body, it shall be three).

- D) Powers and Functions of Governing Body
  - i) To provide or purchase land, building premises, furniture equipment and other means needed for carrying on the work of the Society.
  - To administer all properties and funds placed at the disposal of the Society for specified
  - iii) To raise funds and shall determine and provide ways and means for the raising of funds from the members as well as public.
  - iv) To raise/receive funds in foreign currencies from foreign agencies as per FCRA provisions.
  - v) To enter into contract on behalf of the Society.
  - vi) To appoint Chairman of a Committee, who shall be charged with the responsibility of overall supervision and execution of a particular project within the framework prescribed by the Governing Body. The Chairman of the Committee may be entrusted with the responsibility to maintain accounts of a particular project.
  - vii) To delegate all or any of its powers to any committee constituted for any purpose or undertaking any specific community service activity of the Society.
  - viii) To determine the Administrative establishment of the Society their salaries and other emoluments, the conditions of service including appointment, termination, discipline leave, and other service matters.
  - ix) To determine the remuneration, travelling expenses, and allowances to be paid to persons lawfully engaged in the work of the Society
  - x) To accept endowments, requests, donations, and transfer of any movable and immovable property of the Society on its behalf.
  - xi) To make its own standing orders to regulate the disposal of its own business.
  - xii) To incur loan for the benefit of the Society
  - xiii) To determine the Bank in which the accounts of the Society shall be opened.
  - xiv) To pass the Annual Report, and Annual Budget of the Society for placement in the General Body.
  - xv) To approve any new scheme of the Society
  - xvi) To execute any other matter entrusted to it by the General Body.
  - xvii) The Governing Body shall cause minutes books to be kept of the proceedings of the meetings of the General Body and Governing Body.
- 09. Powers and Function of Office Bearers:
- A) Powers and Functions of President:
  - The President shall be the Chief Executive of the Society.
  - The President shall preside over all the meetings of the General Body and Governing Body convened from time to time.
  - iii) The President shall convene the Annual General Body Meeting, Special General Body Meeting, Governing Body Meeting, and such other meetings as may be required from time to
  - The President shall be the custodian of the properties and documents of the Society.
  - v) The President shall collect funds and spend the same for the Society subject to the provisions of the budget approved by the General Body.
  - vi) The President shall sign all documents letters, on behalf of the Society.
  - vii) The President shall also execute such other works as may be assigned by the Governing Body or General Body from time to time.
- B) Powers and Functions of the Vice-President: The Vice President shall exercise the powers and functions of the President in the absence of the latter or if the President so desires.
- C) Powers and Functions of the Secretary:
  - The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Governing Body and General Body.
  - ii) The Secretary shall execute various works as may be assigned by the President, Governing Body or General Body from time to time.
- D) Powers and Functions of the Additional Secretary: The Additional Secretary shall assist the Secretary in due discharge of his functions and act as the Secretary in his absence.

## 10. Accounts and Audit:

i) The Accounts of the Society shall be opened in any Scheduled Banks as decided by the

ii) The Bank Accounts of the Society shall be operated by two members of the Society to be determined by the Governing Body. One of the members to operate accounts could be Treasurer, Chairman / Members of various committees formed for projects and programmes may be authorized to operate the Bank Accounts of concerned activity.

iii)The accounts of the Society shall be audited annually by a qualified auditor or Government Auditor as the case may be. A copy of the Annual Audit Report will be sent to respective

funding agencies as well as to Registrar of Socities, Odisha, Cuttack.

11. Amendment: These rules shall not be repeated, amended or altered except by Resolution passed by majority of not less than three-fifth of the members of the General Body present at an Ordinary Meeting and confirmed by resolution passed by Extraordinary General Body Meeting of the Society.

12. Dissolution: The Society may be dissolved by 3/5th of Members. Upon dissolution of the Society its assets will be handed over to a similar registered society of to Government after

clearing up all its debts and liabilities.

13. Legal Action: The Secretary may sue or be sued on behalf of the Society for movable and immovable properties.

14. Certified that there is no other registered Society in the same name and at the same place.

15. Certified that this is the true and correct copy of the Memorandum and Rules and Regulations of the Rotary Club of Bhubaneswar Heritage Social Service Society.

16. Certified that this is a non-political, non-profit charitable Society.

17. Certified that all legal matters have been guided by the Society as per rules of Soceity Act, 1860 and its Amendment, 1969.






